Research Programs

The PURPLE Translational registry was established in 2016 for people affected by pancreatic cancer. An Australian-based, multisite, multidisciplinary data framework, the PURPLE registry aims to translate novel research findings from "benchto-bedside".

Under the direction of Dr Belinda Lee, Medical Oncologist and Clinical Researcher from WEHI, the PURPLE Registry aims to improve existing detection methods and developing more effective therapies for pancreatic cancer.

The Program is the first-of-its-kind:

- Australian-based international registry
- Multidisciplinary governance structure
- Framework for multiple research studies, clinical trials
